



## **Detective, Carlo Davila**

Carlo Davila has been with the Milwaukee Police Department for over 22 years and a Detective for 16 years. He started out as a patrol officer and then was moved over to the Vice Control Division where he worked in an undercover capacity.

Detective Davila continued in various roles working in the narcotics field and was then accepted to the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA), Drug Gang Task Force. As a Task Force officer, Detective Davila worked with the FBI, DEA, ATF and US Marshals to identify, disrupt and dismantle violent drug gangs, by way of wire taps, surveillance, counter surveillance and the use of grand jury's in the Federal Court system.

After 11 years in the narcotics field, Detective Davila moved over to the Criminal Investigation Bureau assigned to the Violent Crimes Investigation Unit. In this role he investigated shootings, robberies and stabbings.

In 2011 Detective Davila was assigned to the Intelligence Fusion Center and headed up the Social Media Intelligence Unit. In 2013 he completed his Protective Service Operations Program at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Academy and became the lead for the Milwaukee Police Department's Dignitary Protection Unit. In that role Detective Davila is assigned to the United States Secret Service as a Protective Intelligence Counterpart. In addition, Detective Davila liaisons with other Dignitary Protection Units for various local, national and international Dignitaries. Currently he is still overseeing this unit as well as recently being assigned to the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center as the Outreach and Training Coordinator. In this role Detective Davila is tasked with developing partnerships in public and private sector groups to establish statewide collaborative information sharing, with the mission to prevent, detect, deter, and respond to acts of terrorism.

In his capacity with the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC), Detective Davila has been certified with the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Physical Security Operations, allowing him to conduct Physical Security Threat Assessments for building structures and critical infrastructures.
